Vira I. Heinz Scholarship Program for Women in Global Leadership Summer 2010 Scholarship Application

(This application is to be used for University of Pittsburgh at <u>Titusville</u> applicants only).

PART 1. Scholarship Background and Information:

Mrs. Vira I. Heinz, Pittsburgh philanthropist, was married to the company founder H. J. Heinz's second-oldest son Clifford. After his death from pneumonia in 1935, she traveled regularly to far corners of the world and returned to Pittsburgh where she regaled friends with travel stories and discoveries. One was Helen Pool Rush, the University of Pittsburgh's Dean of Women. It was she who encouraged Vira Heinz to help outstanding undergraduate women share in the life-changing experience of international travel. In the 1950's, Mrs. Vira I. Heinz began writing out a \$1,000 check each fall to a junior woman to pay for a summer in Europe. Her purpose was to enhance young women's self-confidence and motivate them to succeed in life. The fortunate recipients came initially from the ranks of tour guides at the University's Nationality Rooms.

Over time, news of the distinctive travel opportunity spread to other college campuses, where Vira Heinz began making awards. By 1980, awards were made at ten campuses plus the University of Pittsburgh's main campus where annual competitions were held for junior female students. The award had increased to \$4,000. Following travel, awardees submitted a brief written report about their project. The program also included an opportunity for new awardees and those just returned from travel to meet an an annual spring meeting in Pittsburgh.

Since 2001, the Study Abroad Office at the University Center for International Studies at the University of Pittsburgh has bee providing coordination and program oversight of the Vira I Heinz Scholarship Program for Women in Global Leadership. The Program's goal is to ensure quality travel and study opportunities and track the individual awardees progress as they complete various components of the program. The scholarship is now \$5,000 per student; \$4,000 is given prior to the study abroad experience and \$1,000 given upon completion of the community engagement experience. Each campus is eligible to receive 3 awards. There are now15 institutions participating; these include the four regional campuses of the University of Pittsburgh.

The program's core components are the following:

- Each of the 15 campuses holds an annual competition.
- > Students apply for scholarship early in fall semester.
- Established scholarship committees at each campus interviews nominees.
- > Scholarship committee selects three awardees from the pool of applicants.
- > During the later part of the fall semester, the University of Pittsburgh verifies awardees.
- > During spring semester, awardees attend two mandatory weekend retreats.
- Vira I. Heinz Endowment sends individual grants off to each campus by mid-spring.
- > Study Abroad experience takes place the summer after sophomore year (rising juniors).
- A debriefing event takes place during the fall semester following the study abroad experience.
- A community engagement experience is to be completed either the spring or summer semester of the junior year.
- ➤ A final portfolio is submitted.
- A graduation/certification of completion event takes place the senior year.

** Due to the financial constraints of many of our students and to the limited availability of funds, should you apply for and be awarded more than one of the University of Pittsburgh scholarships listed below, you are permitted to accept only one: Nationality Rooms Scholarship, Pitt in China Scholarship, Vira I. Heinz Scholarship, Ticket around the World/Show them the World Scholarship. Note that this list is subject to change. Thank you for your cooperation.

- Be an undergraduate woman of sophomore status.
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Be a full-time student at the University of Pittsburgh Titusville Campus
- Not already hold a baccalaureate degree.
- Have a QPA of not less than 3.0.
- Have been registered as a full-time student for two (2) terms and be returning to the University of Pittsburgh as a full-time student immediately after his study abroad experience.
- Participate in summer study abroad program for at least 4 weeks (28 days or more) in the international host country and are participating in a program for academic credit.
- Construct a study proposal that reflects one or more of the five major programming areas of the Heinz Endowments (Arts and Culture; Children, Youth, and families; Economic Opportunity; Education; and the Environment)
- Express interest in employment or graduate study in Southwestern Pennsylvania after graduation.
- Be available to attend the mandatory weekend retreats during the Spring term, a debriefing event in the Fall following the study abroad experience, and complete an internship/community engagement experience during the Spring or Summer terms after completion of the study abroad program.
- Submit a detailed follow-up report, expense report, and photo journal of the experience.
- Women who have not had an overseas experience or who may not otherwise have such
 experiences due to financial, academic, or personal reasons are strongly encouraged to apply.

Awards Are Based on the Following Criteria:

- Quality of study proposal and how it relates to one or more of the five programming areas of the Heinz Endowments.
- Academic performance.
- Interview with the Vira I. Heinz Scholarship Selection Committee (note: not all applicants are granted an interview).
