## Deitrich School of Arts and Science History of Art and Architecture Department (HAA) Architecture – Design Minor

Those working in many aspects of Civil Engineering, particularly in structural engineering and other building sciences, work intimately with architects. The Architecture – Design Minor provides an opportunity for students to obtain experience and understanding of various aspects of the architecture profession.

The minor requires the completion of 18 credits as follows:

HAA 0940	Approaches to the Built Environment (3cr.)
HAA 1913	Foundation Studio 1 (6cr.) (must receive grade of C or better to progress to HAA 1916)
HAA 1916	Design Studio 1 (6cr.)

One course (3 cr.) in architectural history from an HAA-approved list. HAA 0480 is the preferred course to satisfy this requirements. The following course are also appropriate for CEE students completing the Architecture – Design Minor

HAA 0480	Modern Architecture
HAA 1475	Modernity and Modernism in Housing
HAA 1510	Pittsburgh Architecture and Urbanism
HAA 1531	American Architecture Since Industrialisation
HAA 1920	Introduction to Historic Preservation
HAA 1923	Global Preservation

#### Two co-requisites are required as follows:

- HAA 1912 Architecture + Digital Media 1 (waived for students who have taken a course on AutoCAD in high school or the equivalent course in the department of Civil & Environmental Engineering CEE 109: Computer Methods in Civil Engineering.)
- SA 0130 Foundation Drawing (waived for students who have taken art courses in high school).

# NOTES FOR CEE STUDENTS

In addition to the CEE-required design courses in four areas, those completing the Architecture – Design Minor are expected to select at least one CEE Technical elective from the following: CEE 1340, 1341, 2340, 2341, 2343, 2347. Typically, this will be CEE 1340 or 1341 (the other being used as a required design elective). Students are also encouraged to complete CEE 2620 as a CEE elective.

HAA 0940, HAA 0480 and HAA 1913 are accepted as Humanities electives by SSOE. Thus student completing Architecture – Design Minor will satisfy their 'sequence' requirement within HAA. HAA 1916 will satisfy one 3 cr. CEE elective requirement.

Due to the restrictive nature of the Architecture – Design Minor, students must generally begin in their sophomore or even freshman years; it is noted that HAA 1916 is presently only taught in the Spring semester.

#### Application

This Minor is administered through the History of Art and Architecture Department (HAA). CEE students wishing to pursue this Minor are advised to contact Dr. Harries or Dr. Casson before applying for this Minor.
